I have been privileged to be put in charge of a reconstruction project at Limakatso School for the Disabled located in Intabazwe, which is about a twenty minute drive from our property. The Next Step interns will be putting in new drywall, painting, fixing the plumbing, and many other projects to prepare the school for the students return from winter break. After everything is finished they will be returning to teach lessons to the kids for two weeks. This has been a very stretching experience for me to be this supervisory role, but I could not be more proud to be here with them and guide them throughout the projects.

Additionally, this time of year at Thrive Africa is known as the busy season. As such, all of the staff including myself are pushing forward non-stop. This tends to be a season where many of us get burned out. As a partner in ministry, please keep us in prayer.
